

Summary
Greens Committee
Nov. 8, 2010

1. The water to the practice green has been completed.
2. The cart path to back tees for #7 has been established with additional touch-up work to be completed in spring 2011.
3. Sod application and repair work for traps associated #2, 8, and 9 will be completed this fall.
4. Drainage tiling to be installed in next week or so for #4, 5 and possibly #3.
5. Two application system for snow mold to be applied to greens prior to Thanksgiving.
6. Women's #8 tee to be enlarged towards fairway. A base with special mix to cover will be added by spring.

Please note - previous three projects to be done by Sparky alone as rest of staff is off for year. Volunteer help is welcome. Contact Sparky or call clubhouse to help.

7. Old practice green to be rejuvenated used for repair segments for damaged regular greens.
8. Irrigation system finally "rediscovered" and repaired on entire course. This has been a daunting task. Unfortunately, it had been neglected for years. We are finally getting back to a decent functioning system.
9. Our fairways and greens will show improvement due to better irrigation and proper chemical treatments. This process takes time and we are starting to see results.
10. Trimming of trees and removal of hazardous dead trees scheduled for a winter project. If we have a reasonable snowfall, volunteers will be able to tackle this task.
